## Tournament rules:

1- Tournament valid for ELO FIDE and FEDA. Also open to players without ELO or age limits. To participate it is mandatory that Spanish players are federated. Players with a FIDE flag other than ESP must have a FIDE code.

2- Both the ranking categories and the age categories are limited to players between the upper and lower range of their category. In the event that a player obtains prizes in two different categories, the highest prize will be awarded. If the amount is the same, the order of preferences will be: 1) ELO Ranking 2) Age 3) Local 4) Female.

3- The delay time is 30 minutes starting from the time scheduled as the beginning of the round. After this time, the player who has not appeared at the board will lose the game, unless the referee decides otherwise.

4- Byes: up to a maximum of three ½ point byes may be requested in the first seven rounds. If more are required, the subsequent ones will count for “zero” points. The maximum number of

cumulative byes of any type will be 4. Byes must be requested exclusively from the main referee. The byes for round 1 will be requested via e-mail and before the end of the registration deadline. Only the Round 1 bye demand that receives an affirmative answer will be valid. The rest of the byes will be requested in writing and signed by the player, in the playing hall using the form prepared by the organization (WhatsApp, verbal demands, telephone or other means are prohibited).

5- Tiebreak systems: they will be applied in priority order according to the following sequence:

- 1) Particular result.
- 2) Number of wins.
- 3) Buchholz-1.
- 4) Total Buchholz.
- 5) Sonneborn-Berger.
- 6) Number of games with black (games not played count as white).

The tournament is subject to the application of the FACV Protocol for the prevention, detection and

All prizes from the general classification of the tournament are subject to the legal retention

in force and will be paid by the organizer by bank transfer after

presentation of the necessary data provided with the form that will be given to the winners at the end of the tournament.

#### **ADDITIONAL REMARKS**

a. Failure to appear for one round or two rounds, even justified, will result in the withdrawal from the tournament.

b. A Tournament Competition Committee will be constituted.

c. Everything not specified in these rules will be regulated by the Competition Regulations of the FACV, FEDA and FIDE or will be resolved by the organization.

d. In the playing hall it will not be allowed to consume food or drinks that are not fitted with a cap to prevent spills.

Trophies will be awarded at the end of the last round. The organization can determine the loss of rights to prizes and trophies in the case of a unjustified absence at the closing ceremony or an incorrect completion of the proof of payment within a maximum period of 60 days.

F. Cell phones and other electronic devices are prohibited in the playing hall.

Exceptionally, the referee may authorize a player to leave the mobile phone completely unplugged in a bag or backpack that will no longer be opened or manipulated during the game. A mobile phone that emits a sound, beep, alarm, is used or is simply switched on, will result in the loss of the game. When the game is finished it is not allowed to use a cell phone in the playing hall. Failure to comply with this rule will result in the expulsion from the hall. The referee team will not be responsible for keeping mobile phones.

Other electronic devices (tablets, computers, smart watches, etc.) are regulated by the same rules.
